



FARLEIGH HOSPICE – CHARITY PLACE TERMS & CONDITIONS LONDON LANDMARKS HALF MARATHON – 4 APRIL 2027

1. Fundraising Commitment

By applying for a Farleigh Hospice charity place in the London Landmarks Half Marathon (LLHM), you confirm that you will:

- Raise a minimum of £500 (excluding Gift Aid) for Farleigh Hospice by 4 May 2027.
- Fundraise exclusively for Farleigh Hospice for this event.

2. Application Process

Your application will be reviewed by the Farleigh Hospice team. You will be notified of the outcome by email.

3. Securing Your Place

Your charity place is confirmed once:

- You are offered a place
- You agree to the minimum fundraising pledge
- You pay the £50 registration fee

Farleigh Hospice reserves the right to withdraw your place in exceptional circumstances.

4. Registration Fee

If your application is successful, you must pay the £50 non-refundable registration fee within 10 working days of receiving your offer email. If payment is not received by the deadline, your place may be reallocated.

5. LLHM Participant Portal

Once your fee is paid and you have signed your agreement to these terms and conditions, Farleigh Hospice will register you on the LLHM portal. You must complete your official LLHM online console registration within two weeks of receiving the LLHM email. Failure to do so means that you may lose your place, and it may be offered to another applicant.

6. Fundraising Targets

You agree to raise at least:

- £250 (excluding Gift Aid) by 31 January 2027
- £500 (excluding Gift Aid) by 4 May 2027

Farleigh Hospice may withdraw your place if it becomes clear that the minimum fundraising targets will not be met. If you have concerns about your fundraising, please contact the Farleigh Hospice Fundraising Team for help and support.

7. Fundraising Platforms

JustGiving is the official LLHM fundraising platform, but you may use another platform if it is set up within two weeks of confirming your place. Support can be provided to help you create and personalise your page.

8. Event Cancellation

No refunds will be issued if you or the event organiser cancels your participation.

9. Withdrawal or Deferral

If you need to withdraw, please notify Farleigh Hospice as soon as possible.

All sponsorship money collected must be sent to Farleigh Hospice.

You must inform your sponsors that you are no longer taking part. It is your responsibility to ensure donors are aware that any refund requests must be made directly to Farleigh Hospice.

Donations will only be refunded if a sponsor requests this in writing within one month of your cancellation (not applicable to online donations).

If you withdraw before the 31 January 2027, your place may be offered to another runner.

Deferral requests will be considered on an individual basis; however, please note that deferrals are not always possible. Charity places for the London Landmarks Half Marathon are applied for and purchased annually, and Farleigh Hospice is not guaranteed places for the following year. As a result, a deferred place cannot be guaranteed.

If a place *cannot* be offered the following year, the registration fee remains non-refundable. If a place *can* be offered, the registration fee may be rolled over; however, this is dependent on Farleigh Hospice securing charity places for that year. You will also be required to meet the minimum fundraising target set for that year, and fundraising must be completed again in full.

10. Photography & Media

You agree that any images or footage of you taken at the event may be used by Farleigh Hospice for promotional purposes across print, digital and social media platforms. Content may be edited and used in any of Farleigh Hospice's materials or platforms.

11. Health & Training

You are strongly advised to train appropriately. If you have not exercised recently or have any concerns about your ability to participate, please seek medical advice from your GP.

12. Liability

You take part in the event at your own risk. Farleigh Hospice is not liable for any injury or loss arising from your participation.

13. Race Numbers

Race number swapping or selling is strictly prohibited for safety and medical identification reasons.

14. Age Requirement

You must be 17 years or older on race day.

Disclaimer

Of the total funds you raise, £157.50 will be used to cover the cost of your LLHM place. The remaining funds will support Farleigh Hospice's work and cannot be restricted to specific services or programmes.
